Online and Mobile Security Tips

- 1 Use strong passwords for all your accounts. A strong password will have 8 or more characters, including letters, numbers and symbols.
- 2 Make sure to use different user IDs and passwords for your financial accounts and any other sites you use online.
- 3 Don't use any part of your Social Security number (or any other sensitive information, like a credit card number) as a password or personal identification number (PIN).
- 4 Don't respond to emails or text messages requesting your account number. Members First Credit Union will never contact you to request your account number over a text, phone message or email.
- 5 Maximize your privacy settings and be mindful of how much personal information you share on social networking sites.
- 6 Be careful about what you click online. Links you receive in emails or on social networking sites can be harmful or fraudulent, even if they appear to come from friends.
- 7 Secure your mobile and tablet devices with a screen lock.
- 8 Keep personal and financial information off your phone.
- 9 Think before you download apps to your devices.
- 10 Keep your computer operating system, your internet browser and your mobile device software up to date.
